

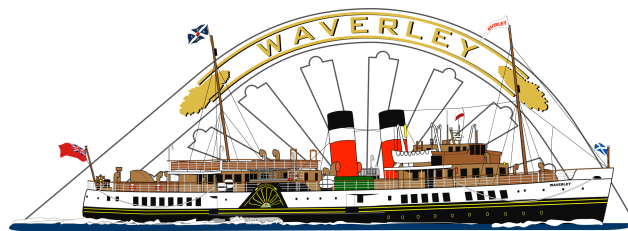

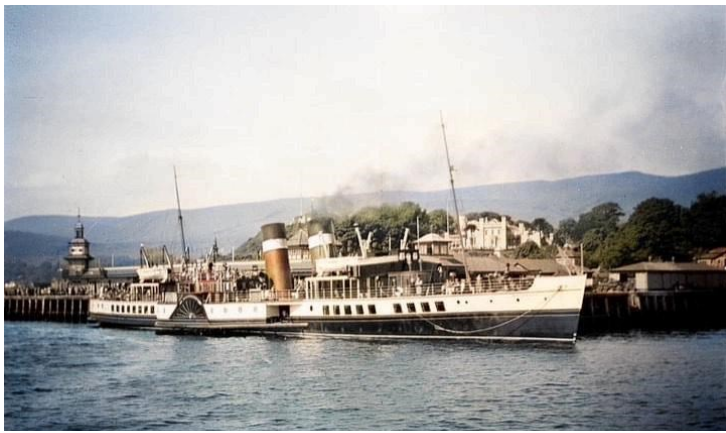

Paddle Steamer Waverley will return to service this summer and celebrate the Diamond Jubilee of her maiden voyage which took place on June 16, 1947.

Waverley offers day, afternoon and evening cruises in several areas around the UK, with the main summer season on her home waters on the stunning Firth of Clyde which begins on June 16 with a special sailing following the route of her maiden voyage up Loch Long to Arrochar.

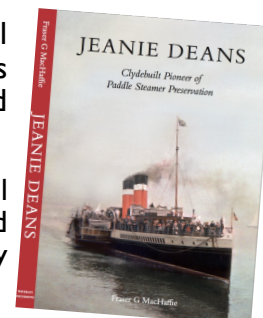
