This year marks the 45th anniversary since Waverley first visited the Bristol Channel and South Wales back in 1979, sailing in the wake of the famous White Funnel Fleet of paddle steamers which operated until the 60s.

Only aboard Waverley can you view and enjoy so much of the Bristol Channel's stunning coast. Step ashore to explore beautiful seaside towns, or cruise magnificent rivers and coastlines.

As the "Sole Survivor", Waverley boasts a rich history and showcases a magnificent triple expansion steam engine that will leave you in awe. With almost 80 years of history, Waverley is a living testament to a bygone era, and is registered on The National Historic Fleet as being a vessel of pre-eminent national significance.

After being gifted for £1 to the Paddle Steamer Preservation Society Waverley has operated on a notfor-profit basis since 1975 and become a "national treasure" carrying over 6 million passengers.

With full catering facilities available throughout your cruise you can indulge in a hot or cold snack, afternoon tea and cake, a hearty meal in the Dining Saloon, or relax in one of the comfortable lounges.

HIGHLIGHTS OF WAVERLEY'S 2024 BRISTOL CHANNEL

Waverley will make her first sailing in several decades from the North Devon town of Bideford with a cruise down the River Torridge and along the Exmoor Coast on Friday 31st May.

The 2024 sailing programme builds on the exceptional success of 2023 with Waverley operating from Penarth, Porthcawl, Swansea, Tenby, Milford Haven, Portishead, Clevedon, Weston, Minehead and Ilfracombe. There will also be coach connections provided from Chepstow, Newport, Bridgend and Bristol to connect with Waverley at Penarth or Clevedon.

Waverley will link with three heritage railways this year to offer the "Ultimate Steam Day Out" where you can combine a trip on a paddle steamer with the ride behind a steam locomotive - look out for trips on the Brecon Mountain Railway, Lynton & Barnstaple Railway and the West Somerset Railway.

Step aboard on day trips to the ever popular resort of glorious Ilfracombe with cruises along the Exmoor and North Devon Coast. Look out for a special sailing to Lundy Island with the chance to steam round Lundy on Friday 7th June.

This year Waverley will partner with SS Great Britain Trust for a special cruise on Tuesday I I th June and with Clevedon Pier to offer an evening cruise on Saturday I 5th June to raise funds for the ongoing maintenance of Clevedon Pier - the only Grade I Listed pier in England.

With so many options available to step aboard Waverley during her 2024 visit to the Bristol Channel there is something for the whole family to enjoy.


